The changing lifestyle landscape has created growing demand for well-qualified health science professionals and the many facets of our healthcare industry provide a varied range of health science career choices.

To help build up Singapore's pool of allied health manpower resources, MOH Holdings, together with the public healthcare institutions in Singapore, are offering Mid-Term Scholarships (MTS) to outstanding undergraduate and postgraduate students with a desire to serve in the Singapore public healthcare sector upon graduation.

As a Mid-Term Scholar, you will be assigned to one of Singapore's public healthcare institutions, where you will be given ample opportunities to practice your field of expertise. Beyond the bond period, there are also many opportunities in the public healthcare sector – from restructured hospitals, community hospitals and research institutes to national specialty centres, MOH Holdings and the Ministry of Health.



Eligibility Criteria

The MTS is open to all Singapore citizens and Singapore PR students currently pursuing a Bachelors or Masters in allied health disciplines at a local or recognized overseas university. Candidates must not be a recipient of any other scholarship or grant that carries a bond.

Candidates will be selected based on their academic grades, supported by references from their faculty/school lecturers and/or professional recommendations. More importantly, candidates must be able to demonstrate their passion, interest and commitment in developing and contributing to Singapore's public healthcare system.

The scholarship is open to students embarking on their final year of studies. Other students will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.

Value of Award

The MTS covers full tuition fees, monthly maintenance allowance and hostel fees. Where applicable, it also includes other student-related claims such as health insurance and visa renewals as well as a one-way ticket back to Singapore at the end of the study period.

Bond Period

Scholarship recipients are required to serve a minimum bond of three years with one of Singapore's public healthcare institutions. Detail of the bond depend on the level of sponsorship.

Application Process

Interested applicants may send in their Curriculum Vitae along with their university transcripts to MOH Holdings at apply@mohh.com.sg. MOH Holdings will arrange interviews with the sponsoring institutions for shortlisted candidates.
